

Curriculum EANLP-approved NLP-Master

Requirements for participants

- EANLP-approved NLP-Practitioner.

Duration

- Mandatory live training hours: 130 or more hours including testing, which must be spread over a period of 18 days or longer,
- In addition, at least 15 hours of supervision (individual and/or group) through a teaching trainer and in the time frame of the training and/or after the testing.

Conduction

- 80% of the training is conducted by a EANLP-approved teaching trainer.
- 20% of the training can be conducted by a different person under the supervision of a EANLP-approved teaching trainer.

Assistance

- An assistant who can at least offer the qualifications of an EANLP-approved NLP Master is recommended for groups with more 9 or more participants and is obligatory with 12 or more participants.

Qualifications of the conducting teaching trainer

- EANLP-approved Teaching trainer
- Has conducted at least three EANLP-approved NLP-Practitioner-trainings

Group size

- A group consists of at least six participants.

Abilities of an NLP Master and Criteria for Evaluation and Certification

- Integration of basic NLP-assumptions on behavioural levels.
- Use of the below mentioned techniques and procedures both on oneself and on others.
- Further development of one's own capacity of perception.
- Ecological development work with oneself and others.
- Ability of distinction of content- and process-levels and their flexible use.
- Advanced rapport skills (ability to construct and work on rapps with groups and individuals)

Minimal contents

1. Presentation and demonstration of daily life and work-specific use through the participants
2. Meta-programmes
3. Criteria and values
 - Identification and utilisation
 - Hierarchy of criteria
 - Elicitation of complex equivalences
 - Adaptation and change of criteria
4. Sleight of Mouth

5. Advanced sub-modalities
 6. Advanced Belief-work
 7. Consolidation of Milton-model and Meta-model
 8. Multi-level-communication
 9. Negotiation models, conflict management
 10. Introduction into presentation and work with groups
 11. Modelling, approach within modelling projects
 12. Working with systems (groups, families, teams)
 13. Extended timeline-work
 14. Integrated models, e.g. SCORE, SOAR, ROLE
- The various advanced NLP-techniques, such as Re-imprinting, Visual Squash, Resolving Grief etc. should be viewed as possible examples for the presented NLP-methods and will, therefore, not be carried out additionally.
 - The contents will be conveyed methodically through theoretically accentuated presentations and debates, as well as practical demonstrations and exercises. The application-oriented part includes observations, self-experience and coaching.

Written test

- The obligatory written test verifies the mediation of the minimal contents and ensures a high-quality standard. This test shall demonstrate that especially the following contents were understood and integrated:
 1. Values
 2. Doctrines
 3. Working with groups and systems
 4. Sleight of Mouth
 5. Modelling
 6. Meta-programmes
 7. Timeline
 8. Basics of working with groups and presentations skills
- The written test's content and formal design is up to the teaching trainer. Written tests are to be stored for at least three years following testing. For reasons of quality assurance, the education- and training commission of the EANLP has the right to request and review the entire archive or single documentations within this time frame.

Practical testing for the EANLP-approved NLP-Master Certificate

- The content and formal design of the testing is to be designed by the teaching trainer and is adapted to the life- and work experiences of the participants.
- The practical testing shall enable participants of the master-curriculum to congruently demonstrate their behavioural integration of NLP-axioms as well as NLP-techniques, in particular: capacity of perception, development work on oneself and others as well as rapport.

Contents of the EANLP-approved NLP-Master Certificate

- The EANLP-approved NLP-Master certificate has to include the following details:
 1. Reference to the adherence to guidelines of one of the EANLP-member-associations
 2. Seal of the EANLP in addition to a seal of one of the EANLP-member-associations
 3. Statement describing the duration of the live-training in days and hours

4. Date of the first and last day of training
5. Signature of the EANLP-approved teaching trainer
6. Title description: NLP-Master

Entry into force

- The Curriculum EANLP-approved Master is valid per January 1st 2009 and replaces the up to date used EANLP-guidelines
